MAJOR GENERAL KYLE C. PAUL

Major General Kyle C. Paul is the Deputy Commander, Combined Joint Force Space Component, United States Space Command, Vandenberg Space Force Base, California. In this critical role, he leads joint and combined personnel across 50 tactical units, unifying space warfighting efforts within US Space Command. He is responsible for planning, integrating, conducting, and assessing global space operations to deliver combat-relevant space effects in, from, and to space for combatant commanders, coalition partners, and the Joint Force. He cultivates strong partnerships with international allies, government agencies, universities, and commercial companies to improve space awareness and ensure mission success. Finally, he oversees geographically dispersed operations centers, including the Combined Space Operations Center, the National Space Defense Center, the Missile Warning Center, the Joint Overhead Persistent Infrared Planning Center, and the Joint Navigation Warfare Center.

Originally from Wakaw, Saskatchewan, Canada, and recruited to play hockey, MGen Paul joined the Canadian Armed Forces in 1994 and obtained a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science and Economics from the Royal Military College of Canada, Kingston, Ontario in 1998. He also holds a master's degree in Human Relations from the University of Oklahoma and is a graduate of the Joint Command and Staff Program and United States Air Force Air War College.

An Aerospace Controller with an Air Battle Manager specialty, MGen Paul's operational experience includes time within NATO Combined Aerospace Operations Centre, NORAD Air Defence Sectors, USAF E3 Airborne Warning Command and Control Squadrons, RCAF Tactical Control Radar Squadron and 1st Canadian Division. MGen Paul's deployment experience includes tours on NATO Operation ECHO, US led Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, Disaster Assistance Response Team Operation PLATEAU, and Operation IMPACT as well as several domestic deployments in Canada and the United States.

Throughout his career MGen Paul has been privileged with command opportunities which include the 42nd Radar Squadron, Canadian Detachment Eastern Air Defence Sector and Air Task Force Iraq.

He has served in a variety of staff positions in Canada. These positions included posts within 1st Canadian Air Division, 1st Canadian Division, Canadian Joint Operations Command, and RCAF staff, as well as serving as Special Advisor to the Vice-Chief of the Defence Staff, Ottawa, Canada. Additionally, he served as Chief of Staff for Canadian Element NORAD and NORAD USNORTHCOM Deputy Director J8 within NORAD-NORTHCOM HQ.

Prior to assuming his current duties MGen Paul served as Deputy Commander for Operations, Plans,



Training, and Force Development, Headquarters Space Operations Command, U.S. Space Force. Throughout his career he has been supported by his wife Jennifer and daughters Addison and Taylor.
